Months Before

- Select & book a florist, caterer, musicians or DJ, photographer & videographer & ceremony officiant

Months Before

- Shop for your wedding dress & accessories (veil, shoes, jewelry)
- Shop for bridesmaids & flower girl dresses
- Select your wedding cake designer & meet for a tasting & to choose a design
- Plan your honeymoon

## 6

Months Before

- Purchase wedding favors
- Order invitations & thank-you notes
- Buy your wedding rings
- Book accommodations for out-of-town guests
- Arrange wedding transportation

## 3

Months Before

- Plan your rehearsal dinner & wedding menus
- Meet with the officiant to plan the wedding ceremony
- Mail your wedding invitations
- Book a hairstylist, manicurist & makeup artist
- Get your marriage license
- Buy gifts for the wedding party, parents & each other

## 1

Month Before

- Have your final gown fitting
- Make sure bridesmaids & groomsmen have their attire
- Confirm details with the caterer, photographer, florist, musicians or DJ, transportation, hotels & cake designer
- Create your wedding program
- Write place cards for seating arrangements at reception

## 1

Week Before

- Schedule some pre-wedding pampering (a massage will help you relax)
- Give a final head count to the caterer
- Pick up your wedding dress

## 1

Day Before

- Assign duties for your wedding party
- Enjoy more pampering (manicure, pedicure)
- Rehearse ceremony & hold rehearsal dinner
- Give gifts to wedding party
